### HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE

#### RESOLUTION 02-18-14G

**WHEREAS**, on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

**WHEREAS**, the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Legislature") is the duly constituted governing body of the Ho-Chunk Nation pursuant to the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Constitution"); and

**WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2 (a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2, (i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreement with other governments, organizations, or individual; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ho-Chunk Nation recognizes adequate and safe road infrastructure is critical to all Tribal development; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Indian Affairs shares responsibility for developing and maintaining roads on Indian lands; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ho-Chunk wishes to update its Long Range Transportation Plan to reflect changing conditions and priorities of the Nation and address the critical need for expanded and improved road infrastructure for a rapidly developing Tribal community.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED** that the Ho-Chunk Legislature, hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to update the Ho-Chunk Nation Roads Divisions Long Range Transportation Plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Long Range Transportation Plan is attached to this resolution as Attachment A and is to be included in the annual inventory update.

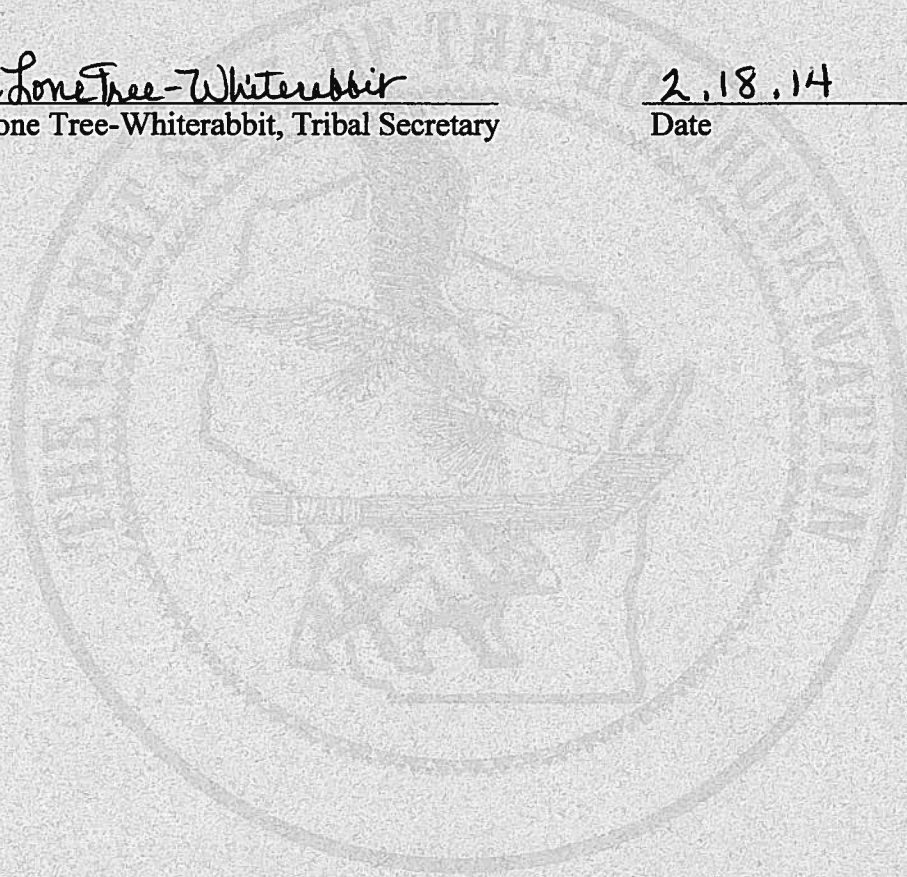

**Subject: Inventory/Long Range Transportation Plan Update Resolution Summary**

Annually the Ho-Chunk BIA Roads Division will review the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and update the plan as needed to reflect changing conditions or priorities of the Nation. The LRTP looks at Tribal, BIA, County, Townships, and State roadways. These segments of road are claimed by the Ho-Chunk Nation as routes that connect Ho-Chunk people's residences, medical facilities, social services, distribution facilities, Tribal businesses, educational facilities, religious and cultural sites, administrative facilities and recreational and hunting areas. The Ho-Chunk BIA Roads Division maintains an extensive inventory of existing claimed roadways and incorporates that into the National Tribal Transportation Facility Inventory (NTTFI). The routes in Exhibit C represent our annual inventory update.
