HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE CONSENT TO BIA FISCAL YEAR 2014 TRIBAL PRIORITY ALLOCATIONS

RESOLUTION 06-03-14L

- WHEREAS**, on November 1, 1994 the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and
- WHEREAS**, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and
- WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of the Nation grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and
- WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2(d) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to authorize expenditures by law and appropriate funds to the various Departments in an annual budget; and
- WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2(i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts, and agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and
- WHEREAS**, Article V, Section 2(x) of the Constitution allows the Legislature to enact any other laws, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes necessary to exercise its legislative powers delegated by the General Council pursuant to Article III including but not limited to the foregoing list of powers; and
- WHEREAS**, the Nation receives federal funds through the U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") as Tribal Priority Allocations authorized by federal regulation, Public Law 93-638, and pursuant to agreements made between the Nation and the BIA for various supportive programs related to tribal government, social services, education and lands; and
- WHEREAS**, the Nation specifically receives three categories of Tribal Priority Allocations from the BIA, including allocations related to: (a) the Nation's Fee-to-Trust Memo of Understanding with the BIA, (b) the Nation's Indian Child Welfare funding agreement with the BIA, and (c) the Nation's agreement to support higher education costs with the BIA (including Johnson O'Malley and Higher Education); and

Executive Offices

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WHEREAS, each federal fiscal year the BIA allocates to each tribe its share of the Tribal Priority Allocation funds, then it is up to the tribe to designate its allocation to the currently funded programs; and

WHEREAS, the Great Lakes Agency of the BIA notified the Nation of the Fiscal Year 2014 Tribal Priority Allocation as of April 15, 2014, and such allocation for the Nation has been set at \$536,654.00; and

WHEREAS, the BIA has requested the reprogramming of Fee-to-Trust funds from the "Consolidated Tribal Government" account code for use by BIA's Regional Office; and

WHEREAS, the BIA's determination of available Program Allocations amount to a total of \$536,654.00, constituting reprogrammed amounts as: (a) funding related to the Nation's Fee-to-Trust Memo of Understanding with the BIA of \$215,000; (b) funding related to the Nation's Indian Child Welfare program and agreement with the BIA of \$88,803; (c) funding related to the Nation's agreement to support higher education costs with the BIA (including HED \$154,351.00 and JOM \$78,500.00); of which each program will be funded by percent of Base Allocation available due to Federal Continuing Resolutions; also to include additional allocations that becomes available during Fiscal Year 2014, or as agreed upon between the Ho-Chunk Nation and Great Lakes Agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation authorizes the above allocations be moved from the Consolidated Tribal Government account code for further distribution to the Tribal Priority Allocations of the Nation as shown by the attached distribution chart.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature, hereby, certifies that the Ho-Chunk Legislature composed of 13 members of whom 13 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly called and convened and held on the 3rd day of June, 2014, and that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 12 members, 0 opposed, and 1 abstaining, pursuant to authority of Article V, Section 2(a) and (x) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 1, 1994, and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
