HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE APPROVAL FOR DESIGNATION OF A CAPITAL PROJECT, HCG-ALL GAMING FACILITIES FOR KIOSK PROJECT

RESOLUTION 06-04-13G

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") gives the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(b) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to establish Executive Departments, and to delegate legislative powers to the Executive branch to be administered by such Departments, in accordance with the law; any Department established by the Legislature shall be administered by the Executive; the Legislature reserves the power to review any action taken by virtue of such delegated power; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(d) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to authorize expenditures by law and appropriate funds to the various Departments in an annual budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Appropriations and Budget Process Act, the legislature can designate capital projects to be budgeted on a project basis with funds being carried over fiscal years until the project is completed or terminated by Legislative action.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature, pursuant to its Constitutional authority designates the current fund account of 900-9388, in each of the HCG facilities of Wisconsin Dells (\$164,000), Madison (\$181,578), Black River Falls (\$144,000), Tomah (\$138,000), Nekoosa (\$143,000), and Wittenberg (\$145,000) in the total amount of \$915,578, (the actual dollar amount may vary as the project is in progress but the amount shall not be more than as identified) for the Kiosk project serving the casinos to be approved on a project basis, with the balance of any remaining funds to be returned to the general fund at completion of the project.
