HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE REPROGRAM OF TRIBAL PRIORITY ALLOCATIONS

RESOLUTION 06-18-13D

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994 the Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation, formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation is a federally recognized Indian Tribe pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(d) of the Constitution of the Ho-Chunk Nation grants the Legislature the power to authorize expenditures by law and appropriate funds to the various Departments in an annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation has three categories of Tribal Priority Allocations from the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs: (a) Fee-to-Trust Memo of Understanding; (b) Indian Child Welfare; and (c) Education: (includes Johnson O'Malley and Higher Education); and

WHEREAS, the Great Lakes Agency of the BIA has available the estimated 2013 Base Program Allocations for the Ho-Chunk Nation. The BIA has requested the reprogramming of Fee-to-Trust funds from the "Consolidated Tribal Government" account code for use by BIA's Regional Office; and

WHEREAS, Available Program Allocations are estimated to be: \$535,851.00, reprogrammed as; (a) Fee-to-Trust Memo of Understanding \$215,000; (b) Indian Child Welfare \$88,000; (c) Education: HED \$154,351, and JOM \$78,500. Each program will be funded by percent of Base Allocation available due to Federal Continuing Resolutions. Also to include additional allocations that becomes available during Fiscal Year 2013. Or as agreed upon between the Ho-Chunk Nation and Great Lakes Agency.

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NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature of the Ho-Chunk Nation authorizes the above allocations be moved from the Consolidated Tribal Government account code for further distribution to the Tribal Priority Allocations of the Nation as shown by the attached distribution chart.
