HO-CHUNK NATION LEGISLATURE APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CY2014 STATE/TRIBAL LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM

RESOLUTION 11-19-13J

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, the United States Secretary of the Interior approved a new Constitution for the Ho-Chunk Nation formerly known as the Wisconsin Winnebago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation ("Nation") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(a) of the Ho-Chunk Nation Constitution ("Constitution") grants the Ho-Chunk Nation Legislature ("Legislature") the power to make laws, including codes, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(i) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature the power to negotiate and enter into treaties, compacts, contracts and agreements with other governments, organizations, or individuals; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(s) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature the power to promote public health, education, charity, and such other services as may contribute to the social advancement of the members of the Ho-Chunk Nation; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(t) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature the power to enact laws governing law enforcement on lands within the jurisdiction on the Nation; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 2(x) of the Constitution authorizes the Legislature the power to enact any other laws, ordinances, resolutions, and statutes necessary to exercise its legislative powers delegated by the General Council pursuant to Article III including but not limited to the foregoing list of powers; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin State Legislature has established a Tribal Law Enforcement Grant Program under Wisconsin Statutes, Section 165.91, which provides grants to tribes to fund tribal law enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, the Ho-Chunk Nation is eligible to participate in the CY2014 State/Tribal Law Enforcement Grant Program for funds by virtue of submitting a proposed plan for expenditure of the grant moneys to the Wisconsin Department of Justice.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby approves the submission of an application for the CY2014 State/Tribal Law Enforcement Grant Program authorized by Wis. Stat. 165.91 for the purpose of funding tribal law enforcement operations including the activities of the Ho-Chunk Law Enforcement Commission and the Ho-Chunk Nation Police Department.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislature authorizes the President and Vice President of the Ho-Chunk Nation to sign an agreement(s) arising out of the Program.
